

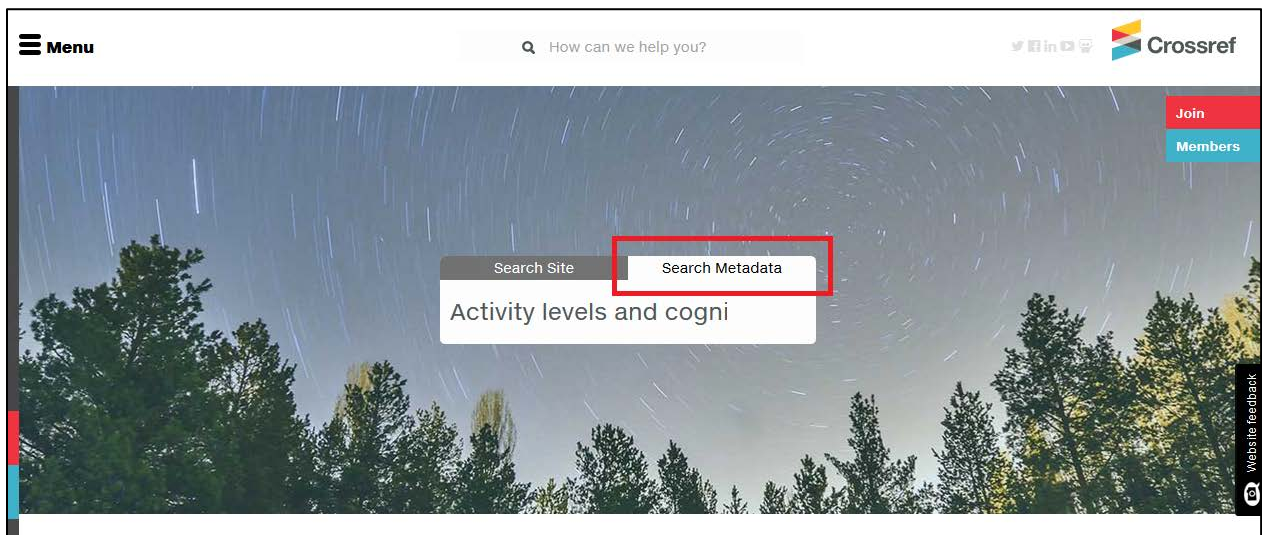
# How To find a DOI using Crossref and Pub Med

## 1 Cross ref

Start with the article citation.

Christensen, H., Korten, A., Jorm, A. F., Henderson, A. S., Scott, R., & Mackinnon, A. J. (1996). Activity levels and cognitive functioning in an elderly community sample. *Age and Ageing*, 25(1), 72-80.

- 1) Go to crossref.org: <http://www.crossref.org/>.
- 2) Select "Search metadata". Type in the title of the article. In this case the title is, "Activity levels and cognitive functioning in an elderly community sample."



- 3) If the article is indexed in Crossref, you will see the DOI included in the listing.

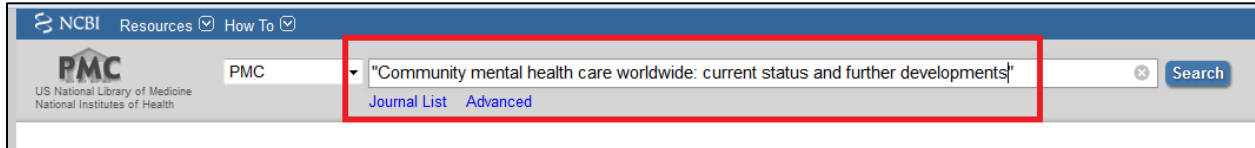


## 2. PubMed

Again start with the citation:

Thornicroft, G., Deb, T., & Henderson, C. (2016). Community mental health care worldwide: current status and further developments. *World Psychiatry, 15*(3), 276-286.

- 1) Go to PubMed Central at: <https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc/>
- 2) Type in the title of the article within "quotation marks". Click "Search".



- 3) If the article is indexed in PubMed, you will see the DOI included in the listing.
